Daily Schedule

Free Choice

All play areas are open for students to choose from. Students develop social skills, turn-taking, and problem solving strategies.

Share Time

Children take turns bringing an item from home to discuss with and show the group.

Calendar

Calendar concepts, gross and fine motor skills, early math and reading development.

Snack

A snack is provided each day. Parents are assigned a day every other month to bring a snack for the class.

Work Time

Includes creative art projects, manipulative activities, games, and fine motor practice to develop kindergarten readiness skills.

Free Choice

All play areas are open.

Music

Incorporates gross motor, rhythm, and rhyme practice.

Closing

Finger plays and stories relating to the letter or theme of the week.

About Our School

Birthdays:

On the day of (or nearest to) your child's birthday, he/she will be able to make and bake a cake at school to bring home. Summer birthdays will also be celebrated.

Field trips:

Throughout the year our older group gets to experience their learning through field trips around the city. They go to the city bus station, library, fire station, and other exciting places as they develop a deeper understanding of the world around them.

Supplies:

A supply list is mailed out prior to the first day of preschool. Each group of students requires a different set of materials.
